Carla Patullo is a composer, recording artist, and storyteller whose work explores healing, memory, and human connection through immersive sound. Drawing deeply from personal experience, her GRAMMY Award-winning albums *So She Howls* and *Nomadica* reflect her journey through cancer and her imagined reconnection with her late mother, using music as a means of processing loss, resilience, and possibility. Her genre-fluid style blends orchestral composition, voice, acoustic instruments, and electronic textures to create emotionally rich soundscapes.

In addition to her album work, Patullo is an accomplished film and television composer, with credits including projects for Disney+, HBO Latino, PBS, and films premiering at Tribeca and SXSW. She has collaborated with acclaimed artists such as Martha Wainwright, Liza Minnelli, and Rufus Wainwright, and continues to create music for film, albums, and live performance, from her Los Angeles studio, The Sundry.
